

Cross-reference of NEMA MW 1000 Table Numbering in 2012 Edition vs. Previous Editions

Traditionally, table numbering in ANS/NEMA MW 1000 led with the part number in which a given table appeared. In Part 1, tables were numbered 1-1 through 1-27 while in Part 3, tables were numbered according to the clause in which the table was first referenced in the test procedure (e.g. Table 3.4.1, referenced in clause 3.4.1).

Effective with the publication of ANSI/NEMA MW 1000-2012, table numbering, except for specifications in Part 2, was made sequential throughout the standard. The following provides a cross-reference of the new sequential table numbering and numbering used in previous editions:
