The above named company certifies that (check **one**)

its self ballasted compact fluorescent lamps which are sold or made available for sale in the United States and which are manufactured or imported after October 4, 2010

its self ballasted compact fluorescent lamps which are sold or made available for sale in the United States and which are manufactured or imported after October 4, 2010, *except for those listed* (See additional form)

meet the following mercury dosing limits

- For lamps less than 25 watts, the maximum mercury content is 4.0 mg or less
- For lamps from 25 to 40 watts, the maximum mercury content is 5.0 mg or less.

To account for technical issues regarding how the mercury is added to the lamp as it is manufactured, the 4.0/5.0 mg limits stated above are applied to the average level of

mercury by type/model of lamp offered for sale by my company, rather than each individual lamp.*

If the above company is not a current member of NEMA, a check for \$500.00 made payable to the National Electrical Manufacturers Association must accompany this form.

If all of the self ballasted CFLs sold or made available for sale in the United States do not meet the voluntary Hg limits, then the manufacturer must submit the sub set list of product types that do NOT conform to the requirements using the *spread sheet for submitting non conforming products* when this application is submitted.

Note: NEMA assumes no liability for any errors that may occur in the submission or listing process. NEMA will make a best faith effort to ensure listings are correct, but assumes no liability other than to correct any errors if they are brought to NEMA's attention. NEMA will not be responsible for verifying that the manufacturer's self-declaration is correct.

** For example, two lamps from the same company and of the same type and model under 25 watts could contain 3.9 and 4.1 mg of mercury respectively, which averages out to 4.0 mg and meets the Commitment.*
